We hope you all had a safe and enjoyable summer. As we start a new school year, we want to take a moment to introduce our two new staff members: Ms. Madyson Grabiele is our new Intervention Specialist and Mr. Carl Gougle is our new math teacher.

Please remember the school day starts at 8:15 am, we serve breakfast at 7:45 am, and we will be dismissing at a new time of 1:55 pm. For those students who have chosen to continue working online for the first semester, please call or stop in if you have any questions. These students should continue working on their Plato classes and can get in contact with Miss Rowlands, Mrs. Deighen, or any of our teachers for assistance. For those students who are choosing to come back to school for direct instruction this first semester, please be advised that you should report to school ONLY on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Your teachers will provide you with online instruction the other three days of the week. Again, please do not hesitate to ask any questions. This is surely going to be a challenging time for all of us, but we will do everything we can to make the best of it. Remember, our FIRST day of school is TUESDAY, August 25th! Also, please note that whatever choice you have selected for the first semester, whether it be online or in-school, there will be a strict policy stating that you cannot change your mind on what you decide. The deadline to choose is the first day of school, August 25th. After that, students will be required to produce a medical note if they want to change their selection OR they must wait until the first semester is over after Christmas break. Thank you for understanding.

In regards to Covid-19, our district school nurse wanted us to remind you that your child WILL be sent home from school if they show any symptoms of Covid-19 or if they have a fever of 100 degrees or higher. Please, please keep your child home if they are sick. Any student with Covid-19 symptoms, even if tested negative, MUST have a note from a healthcare provider stating that it is safe for them to return to school. If any student has a positive Covid-19 test, we will move forward as necessary per the mandates of the state and the health department. Lastly, please note that masks are required by all students, staff, and visitors while in the school building.
